DRAMA: (All Ages) Facilitated by Lisa Ayers

Cost: \$45 per 6 wk. session

Date/Time: Mondays 3:30 pm-5:30 pm

Attention Aspiring Actors! Explore the Art of Theatre with fun-filled games that are the tools of the professional actor. Skills will include: Theatre Terminology, Blocking & Stage Directions, Pantomime, Improvisation, Voice & Diction, Audition Skills, and Character Development. Students also learn by acting out stories in "Story Theatre". All participants will play principle as well as supporting roles. **NO SCHOLARSHIPS AVAILABLE.**

GUITAR: (Olders-Elders) Facilitated by Mark Ransom and Patrick Pearsall

Cost: \$25 per 6 week session

Date/Time: Tuesdays and Thursdays 8:00 am- 9 am

There are two spaces available for Session 3.

Fifth through Eighth Grade students of all experience levels are welcome to come and strum along as basic guitar skills are taught. Bring your own instrument (*Guitars are available for rent or purchase at local music stores.*)

Students attending both Guitar & Roots may register for both Activities & pay reduced registration fee of \$35 per 6 week session.

ROOTS MUSIC :(Must be an Elder) Facilitated by Mark Ransom and Brendan Slevin

Cost: \$25 per 6 wk session. Date/Time: Wednesdays and Fridays 8:00am-9:00am

Vocals, percussion and guitars blend a mix of music as unique as Westside Village itself. Students (ELDERS) are taught to appreciate a variety of different types of music as well as the origins of each style played; they will also write lyrics and music to be performed at school performances.

Date/Time: Wednesdays 2 pm-3 pm

Young technical minds (5-9 years old) learn the basics of engineering and building as they plan and build masterpieces from Lego's© building sets.

ROBOTICS: (9 yrs-14 yrs) Facilitated by Jack Nicklaw & Cassidy Hubbs

Cost: \$35 per 6 week session

Date/Time: Wednesdays 2 pm-3 pm extra meeting times will be added for competing teams

For students 9 years of age and up, this builds on the foundations taught in Lego club and expands it into the field of robotics. Logic and consequences are taught as students input instructions into computers that will cause robots to perform certain maneuvers.

EXTENDED CARE FOR K'S (Special K's):Facilitated various Contract Staff

Cost: \$240 per 6 week session

Date/Time: Monday through Friday 12:15 pm – 3:30pm except on Wednesdays, end time is 2pm.

Teachers integrate kindergarteners into regularly scheduled programs and continue to provide opportunities to explore communicate and create in a fun and supportive environment during their extended day.

Kindergarteners enrolled in this program will finish their day at the same time as all other WVMS students.

We will explore our voices individually and as a group to develop confidence, strength in our voices, our musical ear, and harmonizing skills. All this we will do in a safe, supportive group setting while learning a variety of songs: traditional, modern, or songs we write together. I will bring forth songs I feel are fun and appropriate for our learning at our level, but the kids will also dictate the direction we go musically. We may sing acapella, or with piano or guitar accompaniment and perhaps incorporate body rhythm and vocal percussion.

SKATEBOARDING: (Youngers-Elders) *Facilitated by Darin Butschy & Stu Thom* **Cost**

Held off-campus at Truck Stop Indoor Skate Park, 1307 NE 1st Street

Kids will be transported to Truck Stop by mini-bus. Parents will need to pick up their kids at Truck Stop at 5:30 pm.

Flip Kicks, Toe edging, Ollies! Come out and learn basic skateboarding skills with a focus on safety, technique, and building endurance. Individual abilities will be added upon so that each student can expand upon their skills from regardless of their current experience level. Participants must have all necessary equipment and safety gear for skateboarding and must sign a medical release (available in the office) to participate in this activity. Also, parents will need to fill out a Truck Stop Waiver & Release form in order for their child to be able to participate.
