DRAMA CLUB: (All Ages) Facilitated by Lisa Ayers **Cost: \$45 per 6 week session**

Date/Time: Mondays 3:35pm – 5:30pm

Attention Aspiring Actors! This club is for you! Come learn some fun drama skills & be involved in a production!

GUITAR: (Olders-Elders) Facilitated by Mark Ransom and Patrick Pearsall **Cost: \$40 per 6 week session**

Date/Time: Mondays/Wednesdays 8:00am – 9:00am

Fifth through eighth grade students of all experience levels are welcome to come and strum along as basic guitar skills are taught. Bring your own instrument (*Guitars are available for rent or purchase at local music stores.*)

ROOTS ROCK BAND: (2nd Year Olders/Elders Only) Facilitated by Mark Ransom & Patrick Pearsall **Cost: \$40 per 6 week session**

Date/Time: Tuesdays/Thursdays 8:00am-9:00am

Vocals, percussion and guitars blend a mix of music as unique as Westside Village itself. Students (ELDERS) are taught to appreciate a variety of different types of music as well as the origins of each style played; they will also write lyrics and music to be performed at school performances.

BEGINNING LEGO CLUB (Centers/Youngers) Facilitated by WVMS Families/Parents **Cost: \$30 per 6 week session**

Date/Time: Wednesdays 2:00pm-3:00pm

Young technical minds (5-8 years old) learn the basics of engineering and building as they plan and build masterpieces from Lego's® building sets.

INTERMEDIATE LEGO CLUB (Youngers/Olders) Facilitated by WVMS Families/Parents **Cost: \$30 per 6 week session**

Date/Time: Wednesdays 2:00pm-3:00pm

Young technical minds (7-10 years old) add on to their previous Lego Club experience! Kids will have more detailed projects to build, and create!

ROBOTICS: (Olders/Elders) Facilitated by Paul Snape & Ryan Bello **Cost: \$35 per 6 week session**

Date/Time: Wednesdays 2:00pm – 3:30pm extra meeting times will be added for competing teams

This builds on the foundations taught in Lego Club and expands it into the field of robotics. Logic and consequences are taught as students input instructions into computers that will cause robots to perform certain maneuvers.

AFTER SCHOOL CLUB (9 yrs-14yrs) Lead by Sharon Foster **Cost: Free**

Date/Times: Mondays, Tuesdays, Thursdays 3:30pm – 5:30pm and Wednesdays 2:00pm – 4:00pm

After School Club offers students more individualized support in order to complete their assignments and projects, because we know that all kids learn differently. This focused environment will give students time to produce high quality, thoughtful, and well-crafted work. CO-ED VOLLEYBALL CAMP (2nd Year Youngers – Elders) Coached by Jim Sears & Other Volunteers

Cost \$45 for 6 week session

Date/Time: Mondays, Tuesdays, Thursdays 3:35pm – 4:45pm and Wednesdays 2:00pm – 3:00pm

This group will focus on learning volleyball basics as well as technical skill building. Open to both boys and girls!

CENTER/YOUNGER SPORTS CLUB Coached by Jimmer Sites & Other Volunteers Cost \$30 for 6 week session

Date/Time: Monday, Tuesday, Thursday, 3:45pm - 4:45pm

A great way for kids to burn energy and end their school day! Activities will vary between games, sports skills, and outdoor play. There will be a focus on proper warm-up, strengthening and stretching techniques.

SKATEBOARDING CLUB: (Youngers/Olders/Elders) Facilitated by Darin Butschy & Shane Caito Cost \$45 per 6 week session

Date/Time: Mondays 3:35pm – 5:00pm

Flip Kicks, Toe-Edging, Ollies! Come out and learn basic skateboarding skills with a focus on safety, technique, and building endurance. Individual abilities will be added upon so that each student can expand upon their skills regardless of their current experience level. Participants must have all necessary equipment and safety gear for skateboarding and must sign a medical release (available in the office) to participate in this activity.

SPANISH CLUB (Olders/Elders): Facilitated by WVMS Staff Cost: \$30 per 6 week session

¡Hola Amigos! A love of the Hispanic culture as well as the language is eloquently taught by Ms. O. This activity provides many opportunities for students to interact with the Latino community and learn about the many issues facing native Spanish speakers today.

WVMS Peace Chords Choir (Older & Elders) Facilitated by Shireen Amini Cost \$40 for 6 week session

Date/Time: Mondays & Wednesdays, 8:00am – 9:00am

We will explore our voices individually and as a group to develop confidence, strength in our voices, our musical ear, and harmonizing skills. All this we will do in a safe, supportive group setting while learning a variety of songs: traditional, modern, or songs we write together. I will bring forth songs I feel are fun and appropriate for our learning at our level, but the kids will also dictate the direction we go musically. We may sing acapella, or with piano or guitar accompaniment and perhaps incorporate body rhythm and vocal percussion.

DRUM SET DRUMMING GROUP (Olders/Elders): Facilitated by Ty King Cost: \$35 per 6 week session

Date/Time: Tuesdays 3:35pm – 5:00pm

Ever wanted to be a rock star? Learn to play the drum set! This fun and exciting group will focus on learning the locations and sounds of the different drums, drum stick handling, rhythm, tempo, and incorporating sounds together. No experience is required to participate. Come have some fun and learn some great drumming technique!

JEWELRY MAKING CLUB (All Ages): Facilitated by Anne Forster-Thom Cost: \$25 per 6 week session

Date/Time: Thursdays, 8:00am - 8:45am

Come learn how to macramé, bead, make earrings, and more! We will be able to keep a few projects, and the rest will be available for purchase, proceeds to benefit WVMS clubs.

CREATIVE MOVEMENT (Centers): Facilitated by Bonnie Walker Cost: \$30 per 6 week session

Date/Time: Tuesdays, 3:45pm – 5:00pm

Creative Movement will provide an introduction to movement technique and dance concepts through the use of dance games and creative play. We will use improvisation and fun kid's music to encourage creativity and exploration in a fun and positive setting.

MODERN DANCE (Elders): *Facilitated by Bonnie Walker* **Cost: \$30 per 6 week session**

Date/Time: Mondays, 3:45pm – 5:00pm

Modern Dance will explore basic modern technique including concepts such as: increased awareness of rhythm, exploration of space, weight shift, counter-balance, fall and recovery, integration of pedestrian movement and initiation of movement from breath. Dance improvisation will be used as a basis for students to begin building their own choreography in a fun and positive setting. We will use structured dance class music as well as spoken word, nature sounds, world music, rhythm drumming and silence. Class format will include warm-up exercises, center work, across-the-floor combinations, creative exploration, choreography and final stretch. No previous dance experience necessary.

TRIBAL FUSION DANCE (Youngers – Elders) *Facilitated by Shalamar Ewing* **Cost: \$30 per 6 week session**

Date/Time: Wednesdays, 2:00pm – 3:00pm

Tribal Fusion is a super fun & interesting combination of African, Spanish, Indian, with belly-dance influence & an abundance of freestyle. A great way to move your body!

YOGA (All Ages, Families too!) *Facilitated by Ryan Re* **Cost: \$10 per person or \$20 per family per 6 week session**

Date/Time: Mondays, Fridays – 8:00am – 8:45am

Come enjoy yoga with the whole family! This class is for beginners and more advanced yoga participants alike. Come start your mornings with a little peace and tranquility!

FLASH MOB CLUB (All Ages, Families too!) *Facilitated by Anne Forster-Thom* **Cost: \$10 per 6 week session**

Ever want to break out dancing in a crowd of people? How about freeze in place somewhere public for a few minutes? If so, this club is for you! Come join us as we explore the world of flash mobs! We'll plan our own mobs, make our own routines, and have an awesome time doing it!

TRAIN TO RUN (Youngers – Elders) *Facilitated by Heidi Mauldin* **Cost: \$10 per 6 week session**

Date/Time: Wednesdays, 2:00pm – 3:00pm

This club will focus on learning how to properly stretch, warm-up, and run! Improve your breathing technique, pace, and speed!

ART CLUB (Youngers/Olders) *Facilitated by Karen Graham* **Cost: \$30 per 6 week session**

This six week art class will focus on the study and analysis of color. Concepts covered will include: Primary and secondary colors, analogous colors (color families), complementary colors, tints and shades, warm and cool colors, and creating a culminating project. Students will look at artwork, learn new concepts, and practice techniques using various media during each class.

EXTENDED DAY FOR K'S (First Year Centers) *Facilitated by WVMS Staff* **Cost \$9 per day (see below)**

The extended day program is a program for KG students who would like to stay past the half-day Kindergarten release time. Kids stay through the afternoon in a fun and academic environment.
